“How Does Sendmail Anti-Virus Save Money for Microsoft Exchange Users?”

A

- Effectively increase the capacity of your message servers
- Lowers the cost of day-to-day administration
- Sendmail Anti-Virus means one-time purchasing and licensing, decreasing software costs
- Sendmail Anti-Virus means a single point for maintenance, always up-to-date and in sync

## Capacity

**Sendmail Anti-Virus.** Installing anti-virus software at the perimeter can effectively increase the capacity of the message stores by eliminating unwanted content. The Sendmail architecture lets you add additional content management filters with no impact on your message store capacity.

**Message Store-based Anti-Virus.** Anti-virus software processing on the message store effectively reduces the capacity of the message store server, typically by 25-30%. Installing other ‘Brand X’ add-on filters decreases capacity even more.

## Administration

**Sendmail Anti-Virus.** Anti-virus software at the perimeter provides a single point of installation, configuration and administration.

**Message Store-based Anti-Virus.** Anti-virus software must be installed and configured individually on every message store.

## Software Costs

**Sendmail Anti-Virus.** Anti-virus software at the perimeter means one purchase and licensing process for the entire enterprise.

**Message Store-based Anti-Virus.** Anti-virus software on the message store means purchasing and licensing for each message store machine individually.

## Maintenance

**Sendmail Anti-Virus.** Anti-virus definition (data) files are updated once for the entire enterprise, anti-virus scanning engine files are updated at a single point, and data files and scanning engine are always in sync and up-to-date.

**Message Store-based Anti-Virus.** Anti-virus definition files must be updated individually on every single message store, anti-virus scanning engine updates must be done individually on every message store, and anti-virus definition files and scanning engines can easily get out of sync.
